NOW COME Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP") and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Public Staff") (collectively with DEP, the "Movants"), pursuant to Rule R1-7 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission's (the "Commission") Rules and Regulations, and respectfully move for a fourteen-day extension of time to file proposed orders and/or briefs in the above-captioned docket. In support of this motion, the Movants show the following:

- 1. On June 14, 2022, DEP filed an application for approval of its Demand-Side Management ("DSM") and Energy Efficiency "(EE") Rider for 2022 ("Application").
- 2. On September 12, 2022, the Commission issued its *Order Excusing Witnesses, Canceling Expert Witness Hearing, Requiring Late Filed Exhibit and Taking Notice of Prior Testimony*. Decretal paragraph four established the date for parties to file proposed orders and/or briefs as October 14, 2022.

- 3. The Movants have been working diligently to prepare a joint proposed order but, due to the press of other matters, need additional time to complete their joint proposed order.
- 4. The Movants request a fourteen (14) day extension of time, until and including October 28, 2022, for all parties to submit their proposed orders.
- 5. The Movants shared this motion with all of the other parties to this docket prior to filing, and no party indicated that it objected to the requested extension for all parties to file their proposed orders/briefs on October 28, 2022.
 - 6. The requested extension will not result in prejudice to any party.
- 7. Public Staff's counsel consented to the Company filing this joint motion on Public Staff's behalf.

WHEREFORE, for the reasons set forth above, the Movants respectfully request that the Commission issue an order granting an extension of time for all parties to file joint proposed orders and/or briefs to and including October 28, 2022, and for such other relief as the Commission deems just and proper.
