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NOW COME Duke Energy Progress, LLC (“DEP”) and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (“Public Staff”) (collectively with DEP, the “Movants”), pursuant to Rule R1-7 of the North Carolina Utilities Commission’s (the “Commission”) Rules and Regulations, and respectfully move for a fourteen-day extension of time to file proposed orders and/or briefs in the above-captioned docket. In support of this motion, the Movants show the following:

1. On June 14, 2022, DEP filed an application for approval of its Demand-Side Management (“DSM”) and Energy Efficiency (“EE”) Rider for 2022 (“Application”).
2. On September 12, 2022, the Commission issued its *Order Excusing Witnesses, Canceling Expert Witness Hearing, Requiring Late Filed Exhibit and Taking Notice of Prior Testimony*. Decretal paragraph four established the date for parties to file proposed orders and/or briefs as October 14, 2022.

3. The Movants have been working diligently to prepare a joint proposed order but, due to the press of other matters, need additional time to complete their joint proposed order.

4. The Movants request a fourteen (14) day extension of time, until and including October 28, 2022, for all parties to submit their proposed orders.



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
