DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC'S AND DUKE ENERGY PROGRESS, LLC'S MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME TO FILE REPLY COMMENTS

NOW COME Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("DEC") and Duke Energy Progress, LLC ("DEP", and together with DEC, "Duke Energy" or the "Companies"), by and through counsel and pursuant to Rule R1-7, and move the North Carolina Utilities Commission ("Commission") to extend the deadline to file Reply Comments as required by the Commission's March 28, 2023, Order Granting Extension ("March 28 Order") issued in the above-captioned dockets. Specifically, the Companies request that the Commission extend the May 16, 2023 deadline to file reply comments by 30 calendar days to June 15, 2023.

In support of this Motion, the Companies show the Commission the following:

- 1. On January 27, 2023, the Companies filed their Joint Petition for Approval of Green Source Advantage Choice Program in the above-captioned dockets ("Petition for Approval of GSA Choice").
- 2. On February 9, 2023, the Commission issued an Order Requesting Comments and directed that "on or before March 28, 2023, the Public Staff and intervenors may file initial comments regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program; and [t]hat on

or before April 11, 2023, all parties may file reply comments regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program."<sup>1</sup>

- 3. On March 24, 2023, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time to file initial comments.
- 4. In its March 28 Order, the Commission granted the Public Staff's Motion for Extension of Time and ordered the Parties to file initial comments on the Companies' Petition for Approval of GSA Choice on or before April 25, 2023 and reply comments on or before May 16, 2023.
- 5. As of the date of this filing, the North Carolina Attorney General's Office, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association ("NCSEA"), the Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates II ("CIGFUR II"), the Carolina Industrial Group for Fair Utility Rates III ("CIGFUR III" and, together with CIGFUR II, "CIGFUR"), the Carolina Utility Customers Association, the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy, the Clean Energy Buyers Association, Google LLC, the Carolinas Clean Energy Business Association, and the United States Department of Defense and all other Federal Executive Agencies have intervened (collectively, the "Intervenors") in the above-captioned dockets and filed their initial comments on April 25, 2023.
- 6. The Companies have been working diligently to review the Intervenors' initial comments. Given the press of ongoing dockets and deadlines, the Companies require additional time to thoroughly analyze and response to the Intervenors' initial comments.
- 7. The Companies therefore request an additional 30 days to file their reply comments in these dockets, up to and including June 15, 2023.

8. The Companies have conferred with counsel for the Intervenors. CIGFUR and NCSEA support this motion and no other party objects to this motion.
