BY THE CHAIR: On October 29, 2013, the Commission issued an order in Docket No. E-7, Sub 1032, approving the Residential Energy Assessment Program (Program) for Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC). On February 24, 2016, the Commission issued an order in Docket No. E-2, Sub 1094, approving the Program for Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP, and together with DEC, Duke or the Companies).

On March 18, 2024, the Companies filed in the above-captioned dockets their Proposed Modification pursuant to Commission Rule R8-68, setting forth changes to the Program.

Pursuant to Commission Rule R8-68(d)(2), the deadline for parties to file comments, interventions, and protests related to the Proposed Modifications is April 17, 2024; and the deadline for Duke to file reply comments is April 29, 2024.

On April 16, 2024, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting a 30-day extension for parties to file comments, interventions, or protests. The Public Staff states that the extension is necessary due to ongoing discussion with the Companies on the Proposed Modification. The Public Staff contacted counsel for the Companies, which consented to the motion.

Based on the foregoing and the entire record herein, the Chair finds good cause to extend the deadline for parties to intervene and file initial comments to May 17, 2024, and extends the deadline for reply comments to May 28, 2024.
