Thank you for your letter of June 19, 2015, regarding the rate increase application of Carolina Water Service, Inc. of North Carolina (CWSNC) currently pending before the Utilities Commission. We understand your concerns about the magnitude of the proposed rate increase and the impact it would have on condominium owners at Sugar Top.

The Public Staff's goal in this case, as in all utility rate cases, is to protect consumers and ensure that they receive adequate service at reasonable rates. Our engineers and accountants will conduct a thorough investigation and analysis of the application. This will include auditing CWSNC's financial records and other documentation related to the proposed increase and, in some cases, conducting on-site investigations of the water and wastewater systems. We will take your views into consideration as we conduct our investigation and formulate our recommendations to the Commission.



Dear Ms. Wike:

The purpose of this letter is to urge the North Carolina Utilities Commission to reject the rate increases proposed by the Carolina Water Service, Inc. The CWS current rates are already higher than those charged in many other areas of the state and they are now proposing to increase these rates even further.

S^{UGARTO}P® has 320 condominium residences whose owners have expressed strong opposition to the proposed increase of over 23% in both the base facility charge and water usage rate and the almost 20% increase in the monthly base facility charge and usage charge per 1000 gallons for sewer service. Our Board of Directors and General Manager also feel that these proposed increases are unreasonable, particularly considering that they are multiple times higher than the cumulative rate of inflation since the last increase.

In these difficult economic times when many of our homeowners are experiencing lower incomes and thus have had to reduce their personal expenses and then live within their means, it seems only fair and appropriate that the Carolina Water Services, Inc. do the same instead of just raising rates.
