BY THE PRESIDING COMMISSIONER: On June 29, 2020, the Commission issued a Scheduling Order in the above-captioned docket that, among other things, set the date for the filing of direct testimony and exhibits (testimony), of intervenors and the Public Staff for August 25, 2020, and the date for the filing of rebuttal testimony of Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), if any, as on or before September 3, 2020.

On August 24, 2020, the Public Staff filed a motion requesting that the Commission extend to August 26, 2020, the date for the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct testimony, and extend to September 4, 2020, the date for DEP to file rebuttal testimony. The Public Staff stated that it has been working diligently on this matter, but is also preparing testimony in three other DEP rider proceedings, and preparing for the pending DEP and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, general rate case hearings. Finally, the Public Staff stated that it was authorized to represent that DEP, North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association, Carolina Utility Customers Association, Inc., North Carolina Justice Center, North Carolina Housing Coalition, and Southern Alliance for Clean Energy have no objection to its request.

Based on the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Presiding Commissioner finds good cause to extend to August 26, 2020, the date for the Public Staff and other intervenors to file direct testimony, and to extend to September 4, 2020, the date for DEP to file rebuttal testimony.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
