FOR A CERTIFICATE OF PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on February 27, Belafonte Farm, LLC (Applicant), filed an application, as amended on September 21, 2017, seeking a cer-tificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 3.4-MW solar generating facility to be located on the east side of South U.S.117 Alternate, south of the intersection with Broadhurst Road, and north of E. Albritton Street (also known as State Road 1316), in the Township of Faison, Duplin County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Duke Energy Progress, LLC.
