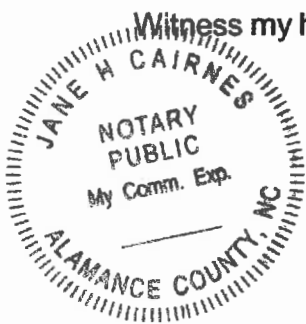

If water service is cut off by utility at customer's request	\$41.38 ^{1/}


