BY THE CHAIR: On November 6, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Scheduling Hearing, Requiring Filing of Testimony, and Establishing Discovery Guidelines, which among other things required the Public Staff and any other intervenors in this docket to file testimony on or before December 21, 2020, and required Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (together, Duke) to file rebuttal testimony on or before January 11, 2021.

On December 21, 2020, the Public Staff filed a Motion for Extension of Time, requesting an extension of one day to file the joint testimony of two of its witnesses. In the Motion, the Public Staff states that a medical issue has prevented the Public Staff from completing the joint testimony of Public Staff witnesses Maness and Boswell. The Public Staff requests an extension to file its testimony on or after December 22, 2020, and a corresponding extension for Duke to file its testimony on or before January 12, 2021.

In its Motion, the Public Staff represents that Duke does not object to the Public Staff's request for an extension to file its testimony, provided that a corresponding extension is granted to Duke to file its rebuttal testimony.

Based upon the Public Staff's motion and the record, the Chair finds good cause to extend the time for the Public Staff to file the joint testimony of Public Staff witnesses


Maness and Boswell until December 22, 2020, and to extend the time for Duke to file its rebuttal testimony until January 12, 2021.
