BY THE COMMISSION: On September 15, 2020, the Commission issued an Order Approving Queue Reform which approved the queue reform proposal as filed on August 31, 2020, by Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (together, Duke). The Order directed Duke to keep the Commission informed to the approval progress of the queue reform proposal from the South Carolina Public Service Commission (PSCSC) and the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC). The Order also stated that the Commission would issue an order subsequent to the approval of the queue reform proposal in the other jurisdictions establishing the effective date of the new revised North Carolina Interconnection Procedures (NCIP).

On August 11, 2021, Duke filed a Motion to Implement Queue Reform Effective August 20, 2021, along with a NCIP compliance filing as Attachment A to the filing. In the motion, Duke stated that the PSCSC issued a directive order on February 10, 2021, and a final order on June 18, 2021, approving the queue reform proposal. Duke also stated that FERC issued an Order on August 6, 2021, approving the queue reform proposal. Duke's motion requests that the Commission approve the NCIP revisions effective August 20, 2021, as attached to its motion. In the motion Duke represents that the only changes to the NCIP filed on August 11, 2021, from the version filed as approved by the Commission on September 15, 2020, are the changes to reflect the new effective date of August 20, 2021.

Based on the motion and the entire record, the Commission finds good cause to grant Duke's motion. The revised NCIP as filed by Duke on August 11, 2021, is approved and shall be effective August 20, 2021.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
