NOW COMES THE PUBLIC STAFF – North Carolina Utilities Commission, by and through its Executive Director, Christopher J. Ayers, and provides the notice required by Commission Rule R8-63(d) with respect to the completeness of the application filed by Edgecombe Solar, LLC (Edgecombe Solar).

On October 5, 2018, Edgecombe Solar filed an application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity (certificate) to construct a solar photovoltaic facility with a capacity up to 75-MW<sub>AC</sub> to be located in Edgecombe County, North Carolina, along with the direct testimonies of Ryan Van Portfliet and Meghan Schultz supporting the Application. Edgecombe Solar also submitted its Registration as a New Renewable Energy Facility pursuant to Commission Rule R8-66.

The Public Staff has reviewed the application as required by Commission Rule R8-63(d) and hereby notifies the Commission that it considers the application to be complete.

WHEREFORE, the Public Staff respectfully requests that the Commission consider Edgecombe Solar's application to be complete and issue a procedural order setting it for hearing, requiring public notice, and dealing with any other necessary procedural matters.
