# MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME

NOW COMES Appalachian State University, d/b/a New River Light and Power Company (Applicant), and moves that the North Carolina Utilities Commission (the "Commission") issue an order granting Applicant additional time to comply with the filing requirements of Findings of Fact 39 and 40 of the Order issued by the Commission in this Docket on March 29, 2018 (the "Order"). In support of this motion, Applicant respectfully shows unto the Commission the following:

1. Finding of Fact No. 39 of the Order requires NRLP to develop an internal AMI opt-out policy and proposed rates and seek the Commission's approval of the policy and proposed rates and file the same with the Commission within 30 days of the Order, and Finding of Fact No. 40 of the Order requires NRLP to work with the Public Staff to reevaluate NRLP's decision to not utilize the automatic reconnect feature of its AMI metering system and to initiate discussions with the Public Staff in connection therewith within 30 days of the date of the Order.

2. In connection with Finding of Fact No. 39, NRLP, on April 26, 2018, submitted to the Public Staff for its review NRLP's Schedule NMSR, Non-Standard Meter Rider, with supporting documentation, applicable to customers who elect to optout of NRLP's AMI system and, in connection with Finding of Fact No. 40, NRLP, on April 26, 2018, submitted to the Public Staff its criteria for remote disconnect meters.

3. On April 27, 2018, the Public Staff advised NRLP that it needs additional time to review the documentation submitted to the Public Staff described above.

4. The Public Staff has indicated that it can complete its review of the submitted documentation on or before May 7, 2018.

5. Accordingly, NRLP respectfully requests that the Commission extend the due date for compliance with the filing requirements of Findings of Fact 39 and 40 of the Order to and including May 7, 2018.

6. NRLP is authorized to state that the Public Staff does not object to this motion.

THEREFORE, NRLP requests that the Commission approve an extension of time to and including May 7, 2018, for the filings required by Findings of Fact Nos. 39 and 40.
