BY THE CHAIR: On or before December 9, 2022, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Duke Energy Progress, LLC (collectively, Duke); Dominion Energy North Carolina (DENC); Mission:data Coalition; Southeast Sustainability Directors Network; the Attorney General's Office (AGO); and the Public Staff – North Carolina Utilities Commission (Public Staff) filed one or more sets of comments in the above-captioned docket, a rulemaking proceeding regarding access to electric customer usage data.

On February 5, 2024, Duke filed a Joint Motion for Leave to File Sur-Reply Comments. In its motion Duke requests leave for all parties to file sur-reply comments on or before April 5, 2024, for the limited purpose of addressing new issues raised in the previously filed supplemental reply comments. Duke states that it contacted counsel for all other parties and that no party objected to the motion.

After careful consideration, the Chair finds good cause to allow Duke's motion.
