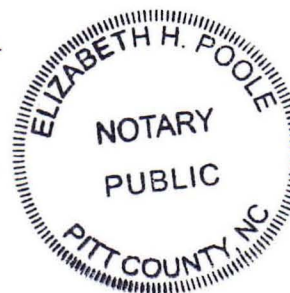

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on April 23, 2014, Carolina Solar Energy II, LLC (Applicant), filed an application seeking a certificate of public convenience and necessity pursuant to G.S. 62-110.1(a) for construction of a 4.99-MW solar photovoltaic electric generating facility to be located at 19919 US Highway 64 in Williamston, Martin County, North Carolina. The Applicant plans to sell the electricity to Dominion North Carolina Power.
