On May 16, 2022, the North Carolina Utilities Commission (the “Commission”) issued the *Order Requiring the Filing of Proposed Orders and Briefs* (“Order”) wherein the Commission order the parties to file proposed orders and briefs in response to the issues developed on the record through filings in the above-referenced docket.

In addition to its Partial Proposed Order filed today in response to the Order, the North Carolina Sustainable Energy Association (“NCSEA”) offers this letter to express its explicit support for portions of the Southern Alliance for Clean Energy’s (“SACE”) Partial Proposed Order.
