Enclosed please find Affidavits of Publication of Public Notices to be filed in the above-referenced dockets.

Timbermill arranged for the Public Notice ordered by the Commission in its Order Scheduling Public Hearing, Requiring Public Notice and Requiring Clearinghouse Review in Docket EMP-118 Sub 1 to begin on Thursday, July 1, 2021 in the Chowan Herald (the "Herald"). As described in Timbermill's July 2, 2021 filing, the Herald inadvertently failed to publish the Public Notice in its physical newspaper on July 1, 2021. The Public Notice did appear on the Herald's website and its e-Edition beginning on July 1, 2021. The Herald extended publication by a week to ensure the Public Notice ran for four successive weeks in its physical newspaper. Thus, the Public Notice for the application for a Certificate of Environmental Compatibility and Public Convenience was published on the Herald's website five times and in its physical paper four times. PUBLIC NOTICE

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on June 21, 2021, Timbermill Wind, LLC (Timbermill) filed with the North Carolina Utilities Commission (Commission), an application to obtain a certificate of environmental compatibility and public convenience and necessity (CEPCPN), to construct approximately six miles of 230-kV transmission line in Chowan County, North Carolina, to interconnect a proposed wind energy facility with a planned capacity of up to 189 MW AC. The application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity for construction of the wind energy facility was filed on June 14, 2021, in Docket No. EMP-118, Sub 0. The CEPCPN application states that the proposed transmission line route will be sited on private land over which Timbermill and the landowners have executed site control agreements for the purpose of the transmission line. The transmission line will originate at the proposed wind energy facility collector substation south of W. Bear Swamp Road and run approximately six miles south, crossing Paradise Road, to interconnect to the existing 230-kV Winfall-Mackeys transmission line owned by Dominion Energy North Carolina, at a point north of the Norfolk and Southern Railroad and north of U.S. Highway 17 Bypass.

Anyone wishing to view Timbermill's CEPCPN application and the detailed maps concerning this project may do so on the Commission's website, www.ncuc.net (Search for Docket No. EMP-118 Sub 1). You may also review these materials at the following Timbermill location: 310 4th St NE, Charlottesville, VA 22902; or may contact Jimmy Merrick at 434-282-2107 to arrange to review the application in Chowan County.

The Commission has scheduled the application for a public witness hearing on Thursday, October 14, 2021, at 7:00 p.m., at the Chowan County Courthouse, 101 South Broad Street, Edenton, North Carolina. This hearing may be canceled if no significant protests are received subsequent to the publication of this Public Notice.

Persons desiring to intervene as formal parties of record should file a verified petition under Commission Rules R1-5

and R1-19, and may file expert witness testimony, on or before Wednesday, September 29, 2021. The petition and any testimony in support thereof should be filed with the Chief Clerk, North Carolina Utilities Commission, 4325 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, North Carolina 27699-4300.

Persons desiring to send written statements to inform the Commission of their position in the matter should address their statements to the North Carolina Utilities Commission, 4325 Mail Service Center, Raleigh, North Carolina 27699-4300, and should reference Docket No. EMP-118, Sub 1. Such written statements will be included in the Commission's official files. If the public hearing is not canceled, however, such written statements cannot be considered competent evidence unless those persons appear at the hearing and testify concerning the information contained in their written statements.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the
 North Carolina Utilities Commission has
 scheduled a public hearing to be held
 Thursday, October 14, 2021, at 7:00 p.m.
 at the Chowan County Courthouse, 101
 South Broad Street, Edenton, North
 Carolina. The purpose of the hearing is
 to receive public witness testimony re-
 garding the application of Timbermill
 Wind, LLC (Applicant), for a certificate
 of public convenience and necessity
 (CPCN) to construct a merchant plant
 wind energy facility (facility) with a ca-
 pacity of up to 189 MWAC to be locat-
 ed in Chowan County, North Carolina
 (Sub 0 Application). The proceeding to
 consider the application for this facility
 has been consolidated with the pro-
 ceeding to consider the Applicant's re-
 quest for a certificate of environmental
 compatibility and public convenience
 and necessity (CEPCN) to construct an
 approximately 6-mile 230kV transmis-
 sion line (Timbermill Line). The Timber-
 mill line will allow the Applicant's pro-
 posed facility to interconnect in to the
 existing 230kV Winfall- Mackskeys trans-
 mission line operated by Virginia Elec-
 tric and Power Company, d/b/a Domini-
 on Energy North Carolina (DENC) (Sub
 1 Application).

In support of its Application for the Fa-
 cility the Applicant filed the direct testi-
 mony of Jimmy Merrick, Deepesh Rana,
 Ellen Balfrey, Emmanuel Wemakoy
 and Jeremy Spaeth. In summary, con-
 struction of the 189 MWAC merchant
 plant wind energy facility is anticipated
 to begin on or about November 2022
 with the expected commercial oper-
 ation date being October 2023. The
 Facility is located east of Sandy Ridge
 Road, southwest of Center Hill High-
 way, and north of US Highway 17 in
 Chowan County. The Facility will inter-
 connect, via the 6-mile 230kV transmis-

sion line, to the interconnection switch-
 ing station and the Winfall-Mackskeys
 transmission line owned by DENC. The
 expected life of the Facility, with future
 upgrades, is 35 years or longer.
 On June 28, 2021, the Public Staff filed
 a Notice of Completeness stating that
 the Public Staff has reviewed the ap-
 plication for the Facility as required by
 Commission Rule R8-63(d) and that the
 Public Staff considers the application to
 be complete.
 Additional information about the ap-
 plications is available for review by the
 public on the Commission's website and
 online docket system at www.ncuc.net.
 The Public Staff is authorized by statute
 to represent consumers in proceedings
 before the Commission. Written state-
 ments to the Public Staff should include
 any information that the writers wish
 to be considered by the Public Staff
 in its investigation of the matter. Such
 statements should be addressed to Mr.
 Christopher J. Ayers, Executive Director,
 Public Staff, 4326 Mail Service Center,
 Raleigh, North Carolina 27699-4326.
