BY THE COMMISSION: On April 18, 1997, Robert K. Koger, President of the North Carolina Alternative Energy Corporation (NCAEC), filed a memorandum requesting approval to change the name of the NCAEC. The memorandum stated that "In order to better reflect the Charter and Mission of the North Carolina Alternative Energy Corporation and to more broadly indicate the corporation's ongoing activities, the Board of Directors recommends and respectfully requests that the word 'alternative' be replaced by the word 'advanced' in the designation of the corporation."

The Commission is of the opinion that good cause exists to grant the request.

IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED that the Commission approves the name change of the NCAEC to the North Carolina Advanced Energy Corporation.
