BY THE CHAIR: On January 27, 2023, Duke Energy Progress, LLC (DEP), and Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC (DEC; together with DEP, Duke) filed a petition requesting Commission approval of the Green Source Advantage Choice Program (GSA Choice Program) tariffs. The GSA Choice Program would allow large-load customers to contract with Duke to provide Renewably Energy Certificates (RECs) bundled with carbon emission attributes associated with the generation, or Clean Energy Environmental Attributes (CEEAs). Alternatively, the GSA Choice Program would assist customers to virtually time-align their energy consumption with renewable energy output by shifting solar energy produced during daylight hours to non-daylight hours. Duke states in its petition that the GSA Choice Program is one of several new programs it will propose to fulfil the directives of Section 5 of S.L. 2021-165 to offer voluntary renewable energy programs.

Based on the petition, the Chair finds good cause to request comments and reply comments from interested parties regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program.

## IT IS, THEREFORE, ORDERED as follows:

- 1. That on or before March 28, 2023, persons having an interest in this matter may file petitions to intervene in this docket;
- 2. That on or before March 28, 2023, the Public Staff and intervenors may file initial comments regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program; and
- 3. That on or before April 11, 2023, all parties may file reply comments regarding Duke's proposed GSA Choice Program.
