MOTION IN SUPPORT OF PUBLIC STAFF'S REQUEST FOR AN OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND TO DUKE ENERGY CAROLINAS, LLC'S MOTION FOR CLARIFICATION AND RECONSIDERATION OF THE COMMISSION'S ORDER APPROVING THE AGREEMENT AND JOINT STIPULATION OF SETTLEMENT IN THE ABOVE REFERENCED DOCKET AND REQUEST TO FILE RESPONSE TO DUKE'S MOTION

On or around February 9, 2010, the North Carolina Utility Commission (the "Commission") issued an Order approving a settlement agreement and joint stipulation in the above referenced proceeding (the "Agreement"). On March 10, 2010, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC ("Duke") filed a Motion requesting clarification of certain changes the Commission made to the Agreement when the Order approving it was issued. Depending upon the clarification, Duke requested certain changes to the Agreement. On March 19, 2010, the Public Staff filed a letter with the Commission acknowledging Duke's Motion and requesting an opportunity to respond to the matters covered therein.

Duke's Motion for clarification and reconsideration relates to the compensation model in Duke's Save-A-Watt approach to energy efficiency and demand-side management. At the center of the Motion is an incentive designed to compensate Duke for "net loss revenues" or changes in revenue that Duke experiences by reason of a new energy efficiency measure. As a potential incentive, net loss revenues are important, yet controversial. A ruling on Duke's Motion will set wide-ranging precedent in this area. Consequently, NCSEA supports the Public Staff's request that the issue be open for comment and similarly respectfully requests the opportunity to be heard on this matter as well by being allowed to file a response to Duke's Motion.
