BY THE CHAIR: Pursuant to N.C.G.S. § 110.1 and Commission Rule R8-60, integrated resource plans (IRPs) for 2018 were filed by Duke Energy Progress, LLC, Duke Energy Carolinas, LLC, and Virginia Electric and Power Company, d/b/a Dominion Energy North Carolina (collectively, electric utilities). In addition, 2018 REPS compliance plans were filed by the electric utilities.

On February 4, 2019, the Commission held a public witness hearing on the IRPs. In addition, the Commission has received hundreds of statements of position from consumers, comments from the Public Staff and numerous other parties, and reply comments from the electric utilities.

Based on the foregoing and the record, the Chair finds good cause to require the electric utilities and Public Staff to file proposed orders on the IRPs within 30 days of the date of this Order. The electric utilities and Public Staff, or any combination thereof, may file joint proposed orders.

In addition, the Chair finds good cause to request that other parties who desire to file a proposed order, or joint proposed order, do so within 30 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS, THEREFORE, SO ORDERED.
